## *Grounds Report*

Hard to believe it's November already, especially as warm as it has been lately. There is still a lot happening on grounds.

Our biggest project right now is to re-build the bridge on six. With all the rain we've had this year, most of the dirt under the cart path washed away. The culvert pipe that allowed water to flow under the cart path had rusted out. This caused the water to flow under the pipe and in times of heavy rains, the water would swirl around the pipes washing away the soil underneath the cart path.

We plan to rip out the cart path and remove the tubes. We will build an earth dam on the upstream side of the cart path. Then, we will build retaining walls on both sides of the cart path seven feet deep. We will pour a new cart path which will be a low water crossing like the rest of the course. This is the same thing we did on hole fifteen and it seems to be holding well.
